# IT HAPPENED! TAX REFORM IS HERE!

The legislation that raced through Congress was signed by President Trump.



Below are items that have an impact on most individuals.

### WHAT CAN YOU DO BEFORE YEAR END?

- 1) Pay all outstanding Real Estate Taxes for 2017.
- 2) Pre pay as much of 2018 Real Estate Taxes as your town will allow.
- 3) Pay all of your 2017 State and Local taxes in 2017.

### WHAT IS NEW FOR 2018?

1) In 2018, Real Estate Taxes, Sales Tax, and State and Local taxes will be limited in the aggregate to \$10,000 (\$5,000 married filing separately).

- 2) Individuals are generally allowed an itemized deduction for interest on a principle residence and second residence mortgages up to a COMBINED \$750,000...PRE 12/16/17 mortgages are grandfathered.
- 3) Interest on a HELOC is no longer deductible.
- 4) Most miscellaneous itemized deductions that were limited to 2% of AGI floor will no longer be allowed i.e. investment expenses, out of pocket business expenses, 2% portfolio expenses that flow from a K-1.
- 5) In 2018, the Estate, Gift, and GST tax exemptions double to \$11.2 million per U.S. person.
